

PRIMUS NEWSLETTER COVID-19 and PRIMUS ACTION PLAN

Recruitment Advice

PriMUS will be guided by GP Practice activity.

We understand that practices may have decided to suspend all research related activity (if they haven't done so already) and are moving to telephone triage appointments only.

For those who are continuing to screen/confirm eligibility of patients and/or have already passed on eligibility information to nurses - <u>Study Visit Part A can take place</u> <u>remotely.</u>

Please ensure patients are happy to be enrolled and are aware that *no urodynamic clinics are taking place at the moment.*

- Informed consent to be discussed over the telephone and each statement on the consent form read out

- TRIPLICATE CONSENT FORM sent to the patient with a stamped, pre-addressed return envelope for patient to initial, sign and post back

- Once consent form received, remaining data in Study Visit Part A collected over the telephone.

 Bladder diary sent to patient, this will be kept until they attend a urodynamic clinic visit.

Urodynamic Clinics

Urodynamic nurses have been advised to inform patients via letter/telephone that ALL urodynamic clinics will be postponed until the situation settles/resolves.

SAE Reporting

Patients who are already on the study may experience **unrelated SAEs due to being hospitalised**. If you become AWARE, or are MADE AWARE of an SAE (patient on the study hospitalised for whatever reason), then please report using the <u>SAE Report Form</u> or call the study manager to discuss this.

You may not be made aware of an SAE until after the SAE has resolved, this is absolutely okay, you just need to report it as soon as you are made aware of it.
